The Certified Compost Leaf Mark Logo is the highest quality standard possible for composted materials as part of the Australian Standards Quality Assurance program.

Fine Blended Mulch is a soil conditioning mulch blended with coarse and fine organic particles and mineral zeolite to create a graded conditioning mulching zone into the soil. It provides an effective, attractive and long-term decorative garden covering. It allows excellent water penetration through the mulch into the soil and with finer particles to blend at the soil surface encourages ideal conditions for the introduction and population of beneficial organisms within the soil.

Fine Blended Mulch applied in a 100mm layer will reduce water loss from evaporation, increasing the efficiency of water applied. It assists keeping roots and soils cooler, protecting them from heat and sunlight.

Fine Blended Mulch will also inhibit the establishment of weeds and suppress existing weeds. As a fully composted product it will break down slowly, last longer and not use valuable soil nutrients to break down.

Fine Blended Mulch is completely organic and naturally processed to ensure all harmful plant pathogens and viable weed seeds are destroyed.

Fine Blended Mulch is guaranteed to be disease-free and weed-free. Many of the mulches currently available on the market are not pre-treated before use and may contain plant diseases and/or weed seeds which may spread and/or multiply through an area when the material is applied; Fine Blended Mulch suits any requirement, from the mulching of containers to the mulching of large garden beds or road batters.

Course	20% > 16mm
Medium	55% 6-16mm
Fines	25% < 6mm

Biological Properties:-

Fine Blended Mulch products have been found to be suppressive to certain plant pathogens for up to 3 years.

Use Enviromix Fine Blended Mulch for general mulching at rates up to 32 Litres/m² or 32mm layer

Enviromix products are produced from recycled "garden organics" (tree & shrub prunings, grass clippings, fallen leaves and general garden waste) recovered through your community's solid waste stream. Garden organics is one of the single largest components of the waste we currently bury in landfills throughout Australia. Enviromix clean, chip, blend then compost the garden organics to the highest standards available, Compost Australia's Leaf Mark program. This is your mark of a quality naturally pasteurized and composted product that ensures all harmful plant pathogens and viable weed seeds are destroyed. The Enviromix process results in quality garden materials that enhance soil health and have the stability of a slow decomposition rate.

Enviromix helps complete the carbon cycle, returning carbon to the soil in the form of mulches and soil conditioners with the benefit of composted humic materials.

Many other mulches currently available on the market are made up of timber chips, or bark which are either aged or fresh. These materials will use up the majority of fertilisers or food within the soil (which is normally available for the growth of plants) as they begin to decompose.

By supporting our products you will be making a significant contribution towards a major reduction in waste to landfills, returning carbon to soils and greatly assist in improving our urban environment.
